



Performance

When used, these tubes are to be connected. See page 2-3.

Measuring range	20 to 50 ppm	50 to 500 ppm
Number of pump strokes	2(200 mL)	1(100 mL)
Correction factor	0.4	1
Sampling time	6 min	3 min

Detecting limit: 10 ppm (2 pump strokes)

Colour change : White → Pale pink

Operating conditions: Temperature 0 to 40 °C (32 to 104 °F) correction used

Relative humidity 0 to 90 % correction not used

Relative standard deviation: 15 % (for 50 to 100 ppm), 10 % (for 100 to 500 ppm)

Tube quantity and number of tests per box: 10 tubes for 5 tests

Shelf life: 36 months

Reaction principle

 $CH_2Cl_2 + CrO_3 + H_2S_2O_7 \rightarrow Cl_2$

Cl₂ + 3,3',5,5'-Tetramethylbenzidine → Pale pink product

Possible coexisting substances and their interferences

Substance	Concentration	Interference	Changes colour by itself to
Chlorine, Bromine, Iodine		+	Pale pink
Unsaturated halogenated HCs		+	Pale pink
Saturated halogenated HCs		+	Pale pink

Other substance measurable with this detector tube

Substance	Correction	No. of pump strokes	Measuring range
Ethyl chloride	Factor: 0.3	1	15 to 150 ppm
